## **CJGT Covid Guidelines**

Out of caution for all players, spectators, volunteers, and course staff, we will follow these Covid Guidelines to keep everyone safe and protected. We will uphold state, local, and golf course guidelines, in addition to the following. It is the sole responsibility of each person present to make an informed decision about their attendance at a CJGT event. If a player does not feel comfortable playing in a tournament based on the guidelines in place below, please let us know. Read and discuss the following with your player. To participate in CJGT this summer, the following guidelines will need to be followed by all players and spectators:

- 1. Players should wear a mask when at the clubhouse, including the check-in table and scorers table. Players should remain outside and spaced appropriately at all times. Spectators should not approach the player tables or be on the practice areas to help with social distancing.
- 2. Concessions may not be available at courses, but if they are, we ask that players not enter the clubhouses for concessions. Snack bags will be provided to players at each event in place of lunch. Any additional snacks and/or water will need to be brought to the course by players. Water coolers will not be available on the courses.
- 3. In place of shaking hands at the end of a round, players may use a "fist bump" or other congratulatory non-contact gesture instead.
- 4. Players should listen for instructions on how to turn in scorecards from the volunteers at the scorers table. Only players and the assigned official scorer should approach the table. Players will be masked and spaced.
- 5. We ask that players and spectators leave the course immediately after completing the scoring. Please do not gather at the clubhouse or surrounding area. All final scores can be viewed later on the CJGT website.

These policies and procedures may be amended, changed, updated or deleted based on the course directives, the CDC guidelines, and the rules put in place by our state and local government. It is our goal to meet all of these guidelines while still providing the best tour experience possible.
